

**Total Annual Giving through the Yale Alumni Fund**

*This year, a record number of 52,497 people made annual gifts via the Yale College Alumni Fund, the Alumni and Annual Funds of the Graduate and Professional Schools, and the Parents Annual Fund. Ranging in size from under \$25 to over \$50,000, these contributions provided more than \$26 million to support the needs of Yale students and faculty. In 2003–2004, nearly 8,000 of these donors qualified as members of the Nathan Hale Associates, which recognizes leadership annual giving.†*
