The establishment of Islamic Theology within German universities in the context of developing Islamic Theology in Europe is a challenge widely discussed in media and politics.

Until recently, this discussion has not reflected sufficiently how Islamic Theology should be pursued and how it shall relate to standards of reason and traditions of thinking in European universities. The question how Islamic Theology will be developed in the tension between traditional Islamic thinking, Islamic studies and Western Theology remains to be a compelling challenge. More profoundly, there have not been specific debates in order to distinguish the different disciplines of Islamic Theology in this new context.

The conference intends to elaborate on these issues by presenting central disciplines of traditional Islamic thinking (such as exegesis of the Qur'an, Sunna, Fiqh and Kalam) in dialogue with philosophy, modern age and pedagogical challenges for theology. It is our main objective to outline the framework of Islamic Theology under the overall context of these seven fields.

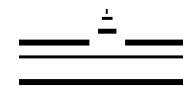
