

Positions available: Student Tutors

The English Department will be contracting student tutors to teach weekly tutorials supplementing the *Introduction to Literary and Cultural Studies I* in the winter term 2017/2018 from Nov 1st, 2017 until Jan 31st, 2018. The workload is three to six hours per week, which covers two to four hours of teaching and one/two hour(s) of preparation / co-operation.

Candidates should be enrolled in the second or third year of their B.A. program or in an M.A./M.Ed. program, with excellent grades and a marked interest in literary and cultural studies as well as literary and cultural theory.

Candidates should send an application containing at least the following documents:

- cover letter
- CV
- academic records (copies of diplomas, student transcripts or module books)
- (if possible) proof of previous work experience, especially teaching experience

In addition to paid tutorials, positions for unpaid tutorials (internships which count towards the "Work Experience" modules in the M.A. programs "National and Transnational Studies" and "British, American and Postcolonial Studies") are also available.

Please indicate in your cover letter whether you are applying for a paid or an unpaid position.
