The candidate and the supervisors undertake to

- conceive and draft the doctoral project in such a way that the candidate is able
 to complete the dissertation, as is normally the case, within a period of three to
 four years. The doctoral period may be extended for familial reasons or to
 account for professional duties and doctoral training obligations,
- jointly review the status of the dissertation at regular intervals (at least once a year), to determine at each juncture the next steps in the process and to ensure that the doctoral project of the doctoral candidate can be successfully processed. At these meetings, the parties should also discuss opportunities for the candidate to participate in conferences and workshops,
- follow the rules of good scientific practice published by the German Research Foundation and the WWU Münster and to consider in particular the principles of open science by discussing aspects of research pre-registration, public access to research data, analysis scripts and materials as well as openaccess publications,
- discuss ethical aspects with respect to empirical studies and the possibility of review by an ethics committee,
- reach early agreements with regard to authorships of publications relevant to the doctorate.

The supervisors undertake to

- comment on the research proposal, work plans, manuscripts and other written reports produced by the doctoral candidate,
- react promptly to queries or requests for meetings by the candidate,
- support the scientific development as well as early scientific independence of the doctoral student; this includes supervision while the doctorate is being carried out and support in acquiring the skills required for it.
- assist the doctoral student in fulfilling their obligations as stated in the doctoral regulations (*Promotionsordnung*) of the Department of Biology,

The doctoral candidate undertakes to

- autonomously adhere to the working plan and given timetable for the dissertation,
- promptly inform the supervisors if circumstances arise which change the nature or prevent the completion of the dissertation,
- to minute the meetings with the supervisors,
- fulfill their obligations as stated in the doctoral regulations (*Promotionsordnung*) of the Department of Biology,
- participate in the qualification program of the OCC,
- carry out the project in agreement with the principal supervisor and the doctoral committee.
