For a better readability just the line spacing in the author and address field is increased by a factor of 1.2. If you use this template and overwrite the things with your own information everything should be automatically right.

Figures and References

Figures are welcome. Please never put figures directly into the text. Please embed them into tables. Figure 1 shows an example (table with two columns, one line).

References are numbered consecutively and set in rectangular brackets [1,2]. Please find below two examples for references, one for a book and another one for a journal article. The references are set in 10 pt.

Important Information

The overall length of the proceedings contribution is strictly limited to two pages. Longer and more detailed descriptions of your original work can be submitted until November 30, 2008 for consideration in a special issue of the international journal "Applied Physics:

Lasers and Optics". The feature issue will appear on June 1, 2009 just in time for the conference. The conference proceedings, that have to be written according to this template, have to be submitted not later than January 15, 2009.
