- Functional knowledge in English
- Functional knowledge in another foreign language
- In case of a dissertation not written in German: Functional knowledge of German

#### 3. Deutsche Philologie

- Knowledge in two foreign languages (level B2 of the Common European Framework of Reference for Languages; One of the languages may be Latin or Greek)
- Students who do not speak German as a native language has to prove exceptional knowledge (level C1 of the Common European Framework of Reference for Languages)

• Functional knowledge in to forein languages other than English
