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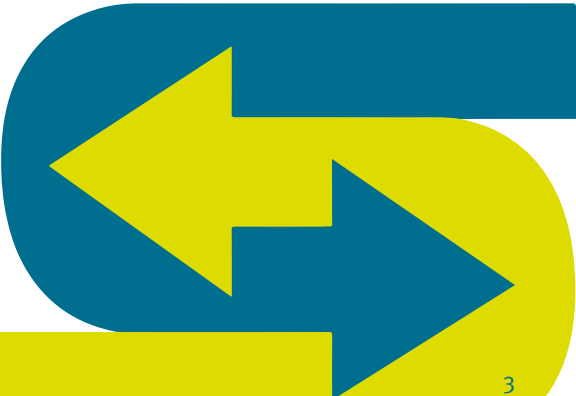


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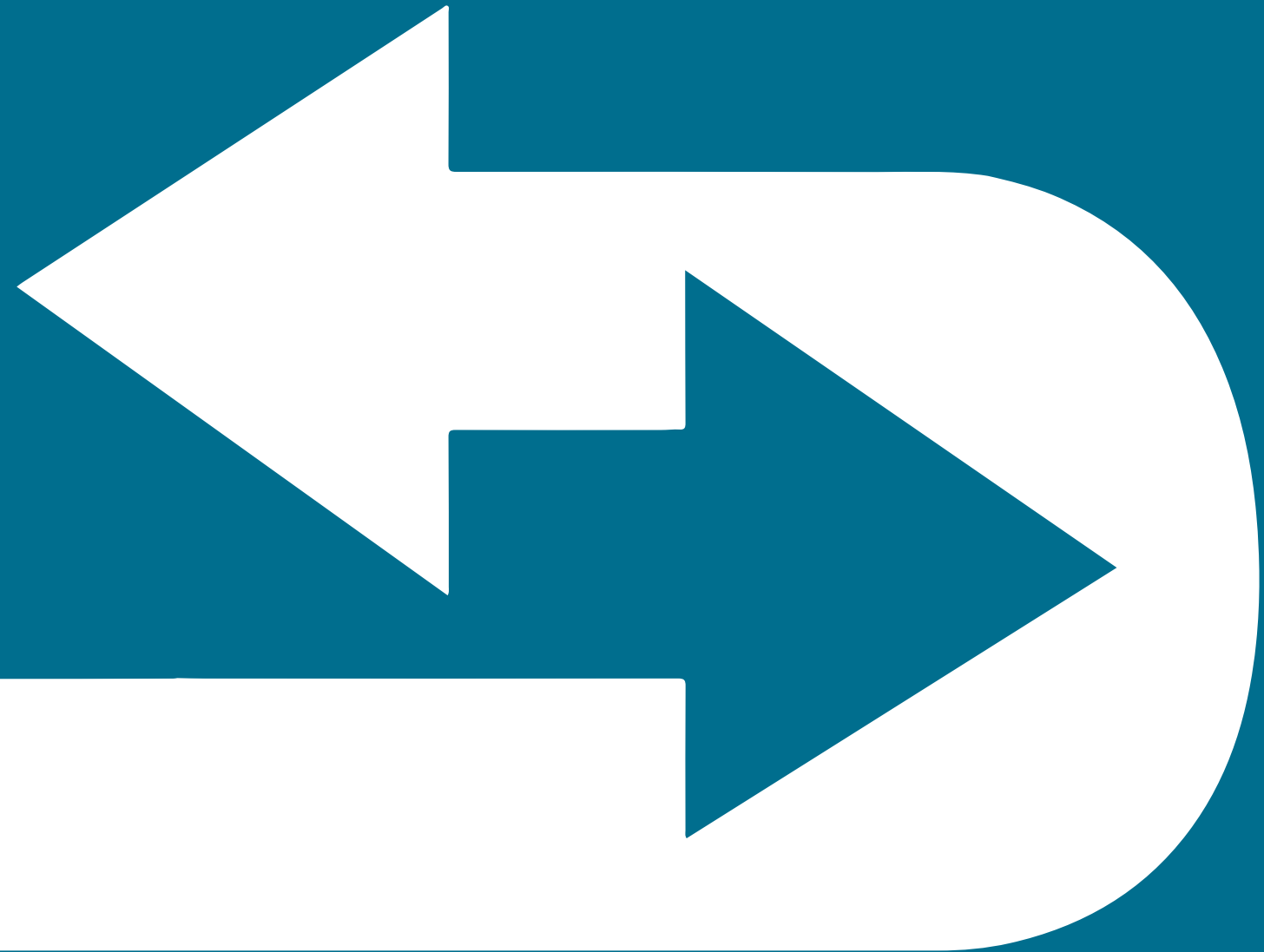


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The Program – the Partnership

Founded by the DAAD

- › **Programm launched 2012** by the German Academic Exchange Service (DAAD) with funds of the German Ministry of Education and Research (BMBF) with the aim to foster the internationalization of the German universities

Summary

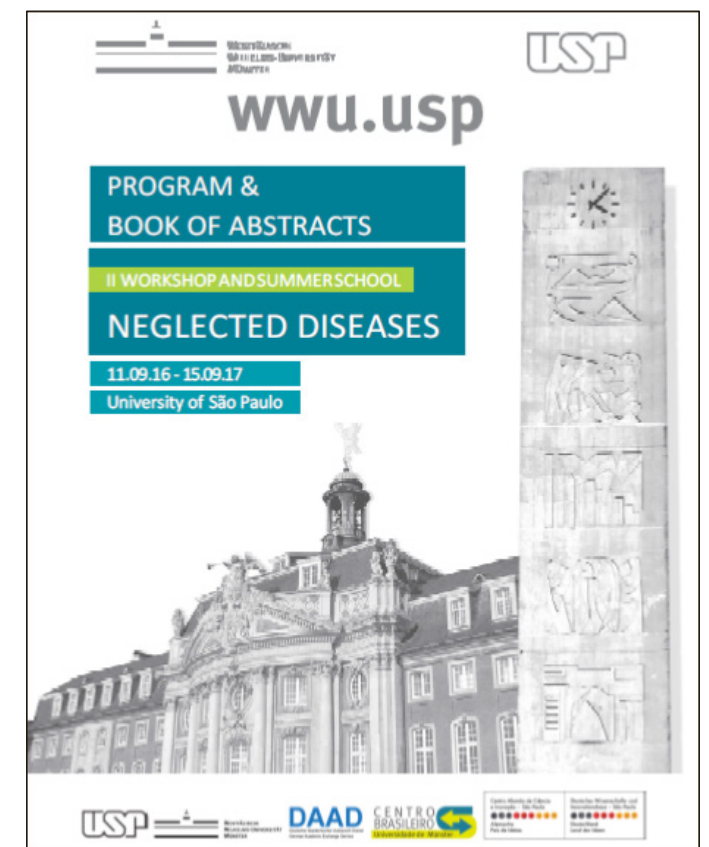

Summary

The participating scientists intend to establish an international research training school (IRTG) to conduct joint research and training of young researchers aiming at new strategies to fight infectious diseases caused by intracellular pathogens. The title chosen for the project is CELLS UNDER FIRE – STRATEGIES TO FIGHT INTRACELLULAR HUMAN PATHOGENS. Working themes and partner groups has been defined.

› THE WORKSHOP

This workshop is a collaboration between the University of Münster (WWU) and the University of São Paulo (USP), aimed at contributing to the knowledge on climate issues in urban environments. During the two days, scientists from both universities will discuss innovative interdisciplinary approaches to address climate issues in medium and large urban settings. The idea is that at the end of the two-day workshop the scientists draft first ideas for joint proposals for research projects targeting towards an international research and training group on this highly relevant topic. Given the relevance, outreach and multidisciplinary characteristic of the topic, several faculties are involved in the discussions.

The workshop builds on the first phase of the project www.usp (2015-2018), supported by the German Academic Exchange Service (DAAD) with funds from the Federal Ministry of Education and Research. The goal of www.usp is to establish an innovative and sustainable strategic partnership by intensifying and expanding the already existing alliance between WWU and USP. Likewise, the workshop will also lay the grounds for the second phase of www.usp, which is dedicated to the new theme "Cities and Climate" and has just been approved for funding by DAAD for two further years (2019-2020).

Scientist of both universities, whose research is related to "Cities and Climate" and who could not be present in this workshop, shall thus be involved in future activities to strengthen the ties and develop common projects within this thematic area. This includes Medicine, Climatology, Atmospheric Sciences, Urban Planning, Ecological Planning, Communication, Arts, Philosophy, Law, Computer Science, Geoinformatics and Information Systems, among others.

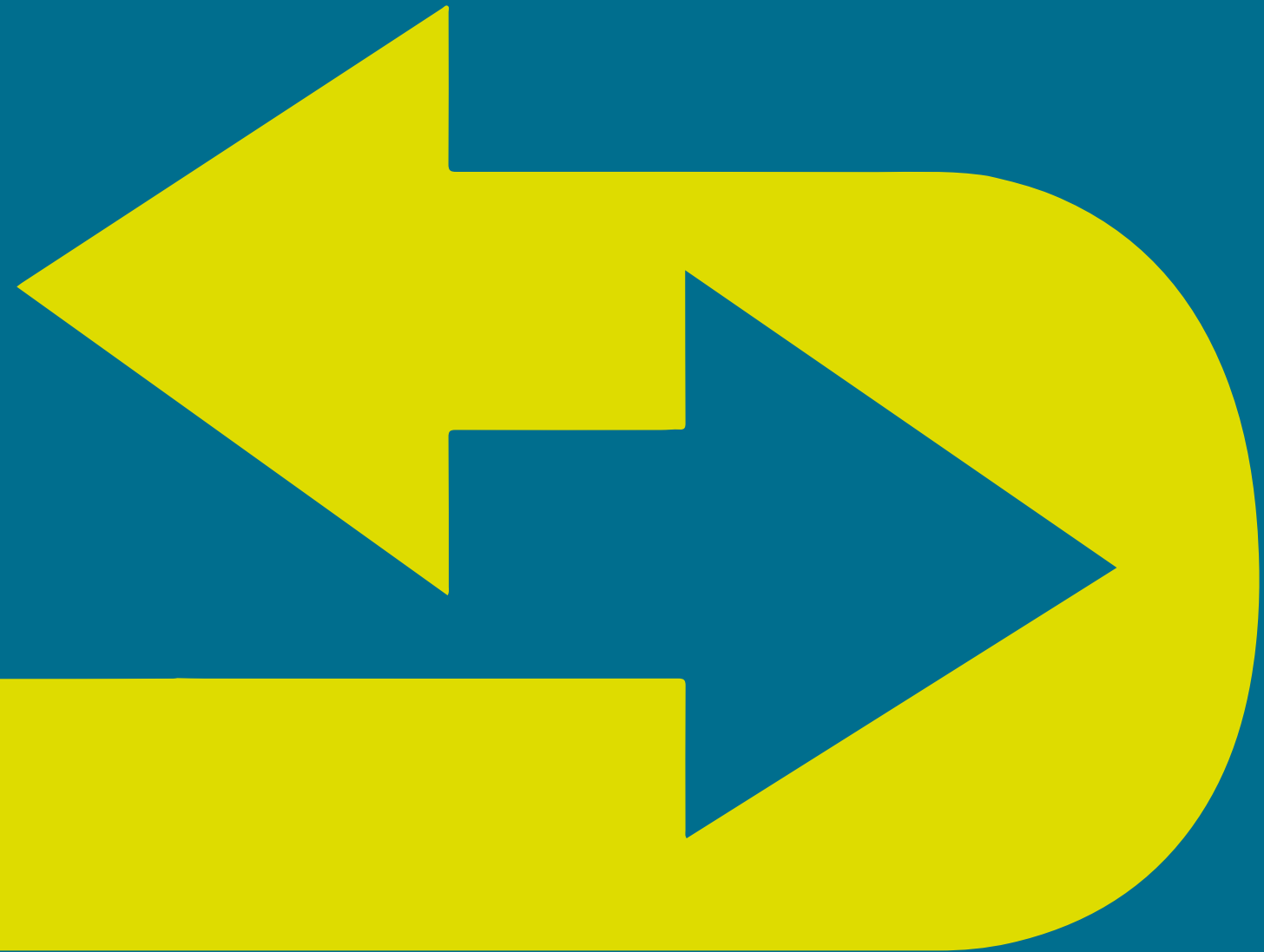

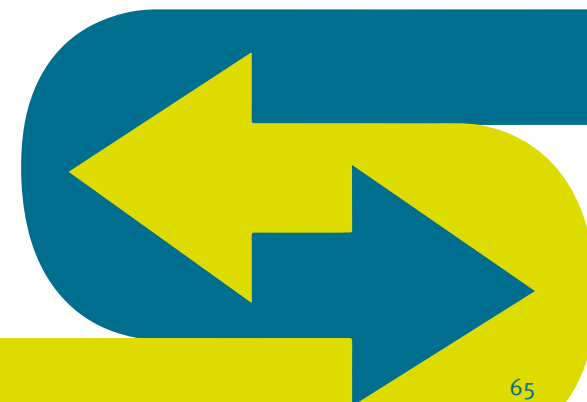

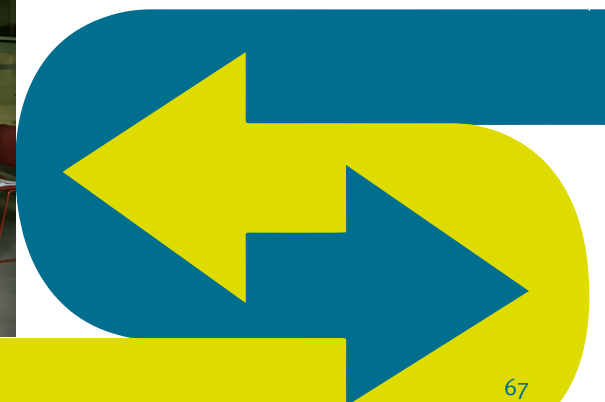
