CV - Professor Ferenc Garzuly

Professor Ferenc Garzuly was born on December 21st, 1937 in Bratislava, Czechoslovakia. He escaped with his parents to Hungary in 1945.

He studied medicine at the University of Pécs and graduated as MD in 1962. Since then he has been working in Szombathely at the Markusovszky Teaching Hospital of the University of Pécs as a neurologist and neuropathologist. He was the chief physician of the Neurology Department for nearly twenty years (1983-2002).

Professor Garzuly was one of the founders of the *Hungarian Clinical Neurogenetics Society* (1997) and the *West Pannon Neurology Forum* (1998), which were established in Szombathely. His main areas of interest were rare and mysterious diseases. The main supporter and scientific collaborator in this endeavour was the *Neurological Institute* in Vienna. With his colleagues he wrote five books on the diagnostic and therapeutic problems of rare diseases.

His further books are: Black Water, Swirling Time – Message of Autopsy Reports (1920-1956) (2006), Unknown Season – Irregular Diary (2008), My Father is reading Newspapers 1953-1957 (2011), Good Morning, Mr. Head Physician! (2019).
