Assistant Professor in Mathematics

Preference is given to candidates working in the field of differential equations, statistics, or modelling of processes and data.

Applicants should hold a PhD degree and demonstrated excellence in teaching. Candidates are expected to be good researchers and should have contributed to the advancement of research internationally.

3. TASKS AND RESPONSIBILITIES

Tasks and responsibilities will include teaching mathematics to students of engineering and sciences. The language of instruction at GUTech is English. Emphasis will be given to the candidates' potential to develop their own research programmes. Interests in interdisciplinary cooperation with other areas of research at the German University of Technology in Oman are considered a definite advantage.

GUTech offers an international and dynamic environment with an extensive research network provided by RWTH Aachen University. The employer will be the private German University of Technology in Oman.

The appointment is initially for 4 years and renewable, dependent on a positive performance review. The salary is internationally competitive.
