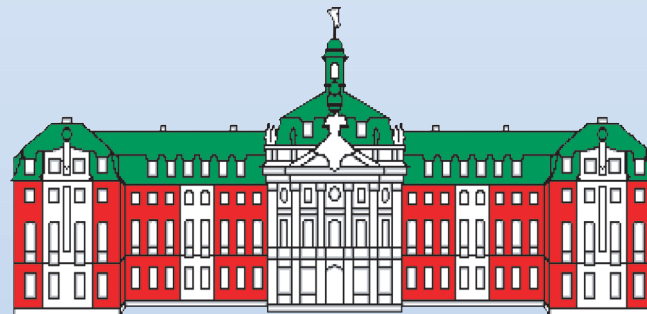
### Poster Presentations
