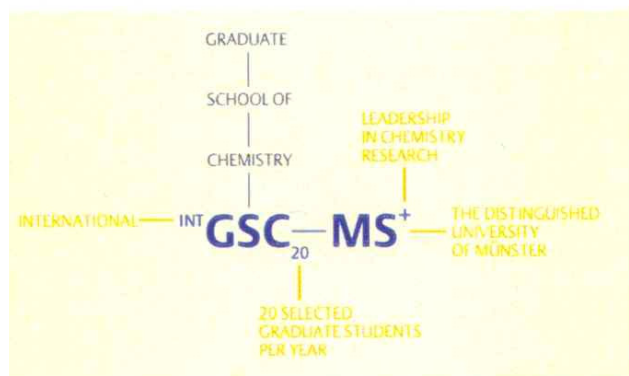

- Coloured abstracts are welcome but not obligatory.
- Abstracts must be available in a WinWord format.
- An electronical version of the abstract has to be sent to Hellmut Eckert or Rainer Pöttgen.
