# **Guidelines for speakers**

Speakers must bring their presentation on a USB-stick. The presentation must be a PowerPoint file and as a back-up, also as a PDF document. All presentations will be presented from a laptop on site. The laptop has PowerPoint 2016 installed. Preferred file format is PPT or PPTX. Please do not use MAC file format. There will be technicians in the lecture room to assist you with your presentation. Speakers are kindly requested to give their USB-sticks to the technicians in the lecture room, preferably early in the break before the beginning of the corresponding session. A pre-layout-check will then be carried out together with the speakers. Speakers should be aware of the time limit of their talks due to the tight scheduling. Invited lectures are scheduled for 20 + 10 minutes (talk + discussion), short oral presentations 10 + 5 minutes.

### **Guidelines for poster presentations**

Posters will be presented on the ground floor of the PharmaCampus, during the whole conference period. The format of the posters needs to be upright (width: 84,098 cm, height: 118,899 cm. Alternatively, smaller dimensions can be used, but the "upright" format is absolutely necessary.) The posters should be put up before the Opening Session and removed from the board after finishing the last session of the conference.

Poster boards are labeled with the number corresponding to the number of the abstract in the present book (for the number see your submitted abstract, on the top right).

Appropriate material to fix the posters is provided at the registration desk.

#### Free "Welcome! Ticket Münster"

Participants of the CK2–conference will receive a free "Welcome! Ticket Münster", which entitles them to any number of journeys by bus and train within the municipal area of Münster, including night buses.
