## <u>Instructions for Using Video Conferencing Technology for Hybrid Events in Lecture</u> Halls with Zoom:

- Step 1: Start the media system using the touch panel located on the media cabinet.
- **Step 2:** Turn on the projector as usual and connect your laptop via HDMI or USB-C. Select the appropriate input on the touch panel.
- **Step 3 (HDMI only):** If you are using the HDMI connection, please also connect the available USB cable labeled "Conference Sound" to your laptop.
- **Step 4:** The lecture hall is equipped with wireless microphones, a throwable microphone, and a lectern microphone. To integrate these microphones into Zoom, you need to select the following in the software under "Settings->Audio->Microphone->":


## "Dante USB Receive(Dante USB I/O Module)"

**Step 5:** To ensure that the audio signal from online participants is played through the loudspeakers in the lecture hall, you need to configure the following in the Zoom software:


When using HDMI or USB-C video:

Under "Settings->Audio->Speaker->" select "AV-RoomSystem."
