The **InChangE Summer School 2022** brings PhD students and postdocs together to address these questions in an interdisciplinary discourse between natural sciences, social sciences and humanities. You will get the chance to explore the relevance of different life phases for individualisation in keynote talks, group sessions and in-depth discussions with peers and invited speakers from various disciplines.
