

*Anthropological Hypotheses about the correlations between Reindeer Herding / hunting  
Even and Evenki Economics and their Kinship Terminologies*

This paper will explore, through the analysis of scientific literature and material from anthropological and linguistic fieldwork (performed between 2009 and 2022) related to the Even (Northern Yakutia and Kamchatka) and to the Evenki (Southern Yakutia and Amur region), what the kinship terminologies and their dialectal variants can tell about the contacts between peoples and groups involved in reindeer herding, hunting and fishing, etc. Finally, the paper will present some questions arising from interdisciplinary projects and ask how one can associate and exploit both linguistic and anthropological analyses.
