## SCHOOL AND FREE TIME

### 1 YOUR INTERNSHIP/SCHOOL

- show initiative, be open-minded. Be open to learning new things
- get to know the British school system, as it is quite different from the German one
- be a part of after school activities, like the *Open Evening*, where you help upcoming students make *Schultüten*



### 2 JOIN THE COMMUNITY

- take any given moment as a chance to speak with locals, they are very friendly and welcoming
- Do you play an instrument? Then there might be a chance for you to join a band (orchestra) in Ipswich
- a lot of concerts are being held in Ipswich, like the *Festival of Remembrance*

### 3 MUSICALS/SHOWS

- Are you interested in musicals/shows? Then you can easily download the *TodayTix* app
  - get tickets for a show on the day for around £30 instead of £100 (it is a massive saving and you can get great seats!)



### 4 LONDON OFFERS SO MUCH

- London is only one hour away from Ipswich by train, ideal for a weekend trip
- Are you a fan of *Harry Potter*? Then the *Wizards Walking Tour* might be for you, where you can visit places where *Harry Potter* was filmed
- Are you a cat lover? There are lovely cat cafes where you can spend some time with kittens or cats and have some tea or coffee

### 5 FOR BOOK LOVERS

- explore many bookshops like *Waterstones* (British equivalent to e.g. *Thalia*) to check out the latest releases, but also get exclusive and sometimes even signed editions
- The supermarket *Sainsbury's* as well as the store *The Works* offer popular books for around £5!
