

Information on the Habilitation Request at the Faculty of Biology

Official inquiry via the Dean concerning the habilitation request (submission of the documents listed below). The request can be prepared in German or English and must include the following documents.

1. *Curriculum vitae* incl. the academic career
2. List of independent contributions to teaching proven by teaching reports (Lehrberichte) including information on the module types (*e.g.* Aufbau-Modul (second year module), Vertiefungs-Modul (third year module), Fortgeschrittenen-Modul (advanced module) and evaluation reports by students; minimum of four semester periods per week (Semesterwochenstunden) for 3 years sorted by:
 - seminars
 - laboratory courses
 - lectures
 - field trips/excursions
3. Supervision of students (B.Sc., M.Sc., B.A., M.Ed., doctoral thesis)
4. List of first authorship publications after the dissertation sorted by:
 - original research articles (peer reviewed)
 - reviews (peer reviewed)
 - book chapters (peer reviewed)
 - patents
 - invited lectures, conference presentations
 - abstracts
5. Research profile
6. External funding, additional qualifications

A board consisting of university lecturers* (Hochschullehrer) examines the documents of the preliminary application and in case of a positive outcome advises the habilitation board that the faculty board (Fachbereichsrat) may commence the habilitation proceeding.

* The board of university lecturers consists of one representative of each of the three main research areas of the faculty.
