As the initial point of contact, the Brazil Centre coordinates and strengthens diversified collaborations of the University of Münster across all faculties. It promotes academic exchange, supports existing partnerships and initiates collaborations in a targeted manner. In addition, the Brazil Centre continuously expands its scope and establishes increasingly more collaborations in other Latin American countries.



The Brazil Centre is the main point of contact for all activities in collaboration with the University of Münster, be it teaching, research, or knowledge transfer. It comprehensively supports its members, students, researchers and Brazilian partner institutions in planning and implementing exchange and research cooperation projects, offering individual guidance and facilitating suitable contacts.
