- modules in reddish / orange / yellowish colours = compulsory modules
- modules in blue = optional elective modules (*Wahlpflichtmodul*), but compulsory for those students who want to become school teachers
- modules in green = other optional elective modules (*Wahlpflichtmodul*). Please note that you cannot switch an elective module after having registered for any of its components on QISPOS.
- in multi-semester modules, courses tied to a specific semester have been placed in that semester; courses which may either be taken in one semester or the other have been placed in-between or near the semesters in question, as a rough orientation. In case of doubt, check LSF or ask the student advisory service.
- the exam regulations require you to pass the foundations modules before electing the modules of the third semester.
