Module III.2 External Module (10 LP)

In the External Module, students attend courses outside the English Department in order to gain interdisciplinary knowledge. Students will **participate in courses from related disciplines**, such as history, philosophy, theology, sociology, and psychology. Students can also count one course in a foreign language at the university's Sprachenzentrum towards this module if they prefer.

At least one course must have a graded assignment (term paper, exam, etc.).

The ideal organizational timeline is as follows:

- End of Semester 2
 - 1 Check online course catalog (HIS-LSF) for suitable courses from other programs or departments (limit search to courses taught in English if necessary)
 - 2 Fill out two (identical) <u>Course Agreement Forms</u> and seek approval from the BAPS representative
 - 3 Contact lecturer(s) and ask if it is possible to join their course(s)
- Semester 3
 - 1 Sign up for the External Module during the QISPOS registration period
 - 2 Submit written confirmation of course participation, credit points and grade(s) as well as your copy of the Course Agreement Form to the BAPS representative

Students should consult the External Module Guide.

As part of this module, students are **encouraged to spend a semester abroad**, to study at another university. Students' mobility is facilitated by the department's numerous partnerships worldwide. The <u>Student Advisory Service</u> is responsible for distributing information on study abroad programs at the English Department.

* Dual Master's Degree: Dual MA BAPS/MEd Gym/Ges students can accredit their MEd courses to the External Module, in particular, courses in Pädagogik and Erzeihungswissenschaft, so long as one of the courses has a grade.

<u>Note</u>: In this module individual courses are **not registered for on QISPOS**. Instead, students received verbal consent from instructors to attend their courses and proof of course completion/grades in the form of written certificates. Individual instructors should provide such letters upon request at the end of the course. All certificates and letters as well as the filled-out and approved agreement form are handed in for course credit.
