Clevedon is a small coastal town in the Southwest of the UK, very close to Bristol which is a very vibrant and metropolitan city with a great reputation for arts and a rich and fascinating history.

Yeo Moor Primary School has been very well rated by Ofsted (the public body that supports school improvement through inspection) and is very committed to professional development. An aspect of British Society that may contrast with some European societies is the generally wider spread of socio-economic circumstances. The school serves a mixed community and some members of that community are from deprived backgrounds.



Accordingly, the work at the school really does matter and trainees would be right at the forefront of giving extra support to children who really need it and whose life chances will be greatly enhanced by it. Yeo Moor is very committed to preparing these children for a modern diverse Britain and is delighted to have the opportunity to explore another culture and meet people from different backgrounds. It is an outward looking school and gives a warm welcome and a good experience to those seeking to enter the teaching profession. A member of staff leads on trainee teachers and new trainees and the latter will get a full induction and be encouraged to attend staff meetings and really be part of the school.

Requirements

Students need a standard of English good enough to teach phonics in English is essential. Thus, trainees need to have a good pronunciation and a good command. Yeo Moor values attitude very highly and an ability to get involved, take on a challenge and integrate well is important. Please be aware that the UK has some very stringent requirements regarding safeguarding of children.

Timeframe

There will be up to four placements during **autumn** (September-December) and four during **spring** (February/March-June) for a three-month stay.
