Norwich School in cooperation with the Centre for Teacher Training (Zentrum für Lehrerbildung) of University of Münster offers teacher students the possibility to do a school placement. The city of Norwich is situated in Norfolk in the eastern part of England. Norwich School is next to the Cathedral in the middle of the historic city centre with nice houses and medieval flair.

The role of the teacher student:

- supporting the teachers in the preparation and development of resources for lessons;
- teaching and supporting groups or the whole class under the supervision of the class teacher;
- assisting the teachers in classroom and with administrative tasks (e.g. learning plans);
- working with and supporting groups of pupils in different subjects;
- creating imaginative and interactive displays of pupils' work in the classrooms and corridors;
- participating fully in school life, such as supporting extra-curricular activities, school trips and other reasonable duties.

The placement includes:

- undertaking a staff induction session
- gaining an overview of Norwich School's operations
- a visit to a state school in Norwich, if possible (1 day)
- contact with the language assistants
- the possibility to observe lessons
- feedback from the teachers
- experiencing other roles in the school apart from teaching (pastoral roles, sports coaches etc.) where possible
- Interns will be expected to be in school Monday-Friday during term time and work a 37.5 hour week, with a one hour lunch break each day

What we offer

- ▶ A complimentary lunch is available at the Refectory daily during term time.
- ▶ Reasonable assistance for finding accommodation may be given by NS staff, although ultimate responsibility rests with the interns.
