

German Language Assistant Wanted: Ashville College

Each year, the TEFL department sends one male student to our partner school Ashville College in Harrogate (UK). This particular position involves both working as a German language teaching assistant and as a resident tutor in one of the boarding houses.

Duties include:

- working alongside teachers in supporting pupils on an individual, class or small group basis to support the delivery of quality learning and teaching and to help raise standards of achievement for all pupils
- teaching time-tabled lessons with students from Year Seven to Sixth Form (18 periods work per week in the College)

Salary:

- £879.00 per month

The fellowship usually lasts from the end of August until the middle of July.

Requirements:

- student at the English Seminar
- male
- a current passport
- good to excellent academic record

- a transcript of their academic record
- a motivational letter in which they introduce themselves, their academic interests, hobbies, qualifications, etc. and state in what ways they think they can contribute to the school life.
