Module I.2 Advanced Studies in Literature, Culture, Linguistics, and Book Studies

The module Advanced Studies in Literature, Culture, Linguistics, and Book Studies is made up of two courses: the mandatory Hotspots lecture and one elective lecture or seminar.

The lecture series Hotspots in Literary and Cultural Studies, Book Studies, and Linguistics aims to give students an overview of current research fields in the areas of literary and cultural studies, book studies, and linguistics. In addition, the module offers students the opportunity to set an initial self-chosen focus by selecting a single lecture or seminar in literary/cultural studies, book studies, **or** linguistics.

Hotspots in Literary and Cultural Studies, Book Studies, and Linguistics (1.5 LP)

In the mandatory lecture Hotspots in Literary and Cultural Studies, Book Studies, and Linguistics, a range of speakers/researchers present current research projects in the fields of English literature, cultural studies, book studies, and linguistics.

As part of this course, students are required to be responsible for one lecture in the series, by **introducing the speakers and moderating the discussion**.

Seminar or Lecture (4.5 LP)

In the elective seminar or lecture of their choosing, students deepen their methodological and subject knowledge in their respective areas of specialization.

At the end of this course, students are required to take part in a **graded 20-minute oral exam**, worth **3.5 LP**.
