In the context of urbanization in India, efforts to beautify public spaces, and to 'clean up' cities, reflect the contested social imaginaries of development. In her work across film, composition, writing and installation, Sindhu Thiruamalaisamy researches processes of beautification and their inherent contradictions to the democratic use of public spaces. In this talk, she will introduce her practice through two films that question the relationships between beautification, enclosure and erasure— The Lake and The Lake (2019) and Different Colourful Designs (2016).
