



Call for proposals – Student exchange scholarships for 2016

The Institute of Ethnology established a partnership with the Department of Social Anthropology at Rhodes University in Grahamstown/South Africa (<https://www.ru.ac.za/anthropology/>). Thanks to DAAD-funding we are able to send 2 BA and 2 MA students – **irrespective of their citizenship** – to the Eastern Cape for studying and research (à 6 months from February to July/August 2017).

Scholarship includes:

Study fees, travel expenses and a monthly rate to cover the living expenses in South Africa, on campus accommodation in Grahamstown.

Conditions

Minimum average grade according to your transcript of records (or: “Studienbuch”) is 2,3. BA students can apply from the 3rd semester onwards, MA students from the 1st semester onwards, resp. after 2 years of studying anthropology or a cognate discipline. Required are English skills on the level of C1 (resp. a score of 7 in an IELTS), an original proposal of about 3 pages and a letter of motivation. That will be forwarded to the exchange partners in Grahamstown. Willingness to learn isiXhosa during your stay there is conditional.

In Germany 2–3 preparations workshops in the months of December and January will be set up – participation is obligatory and a way to acquire up to 5 CP (credit points).
