Workshop on introduction to The Bloomsbury Cultural Formulation Interview

In the framework of the practice-oriented course Transcultural Psychiatry, a public workshop on the introduction of the "Bloomsbury Cultural Formulation Interview" will be held on May 12, 2017, which will examine the practical and interdisciplinary cooperation in a sensitive field. The seminar is addressing students of the BA course Cultural and Social Anthropology (Module IV) who will gain insights into the interdisciplinary field of transcultural psychiatry during the semester as well as conduct their own research projects. The workshop will be led by the guest lecturers Dr. Sushrut Jadhav (University College London) and Dr. Sengupta Samrat (Broadmoor Hospital). The interactive and experiential workshop — conducted by clinician anthropologists — is aimed at clinicians and social scientists working with people suffering from mental distress. Participants will be introduced to cutting-edge concepts of applied medical anthropology and learn skills to conduct a clinical cultural interview. The workshop will help understand innovations in appreciating how cultural identity is critical for engaging, assessing, treating and researching mental distress across cultures.
