

## **THE POSTER SESSIONS**

Poster sessions are scheduled for Thursday and Friday (September 6 and 7) after the plenary talks in the morning and will be held in the same building as the plenary talks (Foyer, ground floor); please follow the signposting.

You should put up your poster on the poster walls in the morning before the plenary talk. An identification number will be assigned to your poster in the programme (check the EuroSLA-Website prior to the conference). You will find the numbers corresponding to your poster on the poster walls. Please stick to this numbering. Pins for the posters will be on the poster walls and there will be members of our team to assist you. Your poster can be removed promptly after the session or can be displayed throughout the day of your poster session until the evening. This will ensure maximum exposure and allow participants to view your poster beyond the official poster session. Please do not forget to remove your poster at the end of the day!

The poster boards are 113 cm wide and 147 cm high. Please design your poster in A0 portrait format (see <<http://www.eseb2017.nl/files/A0-singlesided.pdf>>).

## **PROCEEDINGS**

- the submitted posters will be evaluated by a committee of three experts that will select the five best posters. The posters will be evaluated for their scientific quality and their layout.
- the committee will attend the poster session to evaluate the presenter's performances of the five selected posters and to select the winner.
- the winner will be announced during the Best Poster Award ceremony, to be held on Saturday, September 9 at 12:10 a.m.
