

Conference

Like a network of bus lanes leaves its marks on the map of Münster with its routes meeting and crossing each other, categories of social difference are imprinted in biographies, their contexts, and finally, in theology itself. Over the last decades, feminist theology and theological gender studies have contributed to the inclusion of gender as a category into theological reflection. However, they increasingly realize that questions of gender cannot capture experiences of discrimination as well as power structures completely. For doing so, the complex network of social differences in its multifaceted interconnectedness of social categories such as race, class, gender, (dis)ability, religion and many more needs to be considered.

The Centre for Theological Gender Studies of the Catholic-Theological Faculty at the Westfälische Wilhelms-Universität Münster invites you to analyse examples of intersections in this network with international experts on theological gender studies

and to discuss their biographies and theological influences. In interactive formats and based on these reflections, we want to work on the following questions:

How can the claim of a gender-sensitive theology be fulfilled when intersectionality is taken into account? How can an intersectional perspective complement and enrich theological gender studies?

In other words: For what and how should theology in general, but also theological gender studies in particular, adapt an intersectional approach?

Call for Posters

The conference reflects on questions of gender in theology from different intersectional, biographical, and contextual perspectives. Alongside the keynote lectures, different projects and research ideas on gender, feminist theology, intersectionality etc. can be presented.

We invite professors, researchers in bigger and smaller projects as well as

young scholars to present posters about their projects and to enrich the conference this way. We are looking forward to contributions from various theological disciplines, different theologies – Christian, Islamic etc. –, religious studies and other related disciplines. The posters (DIN-A1; language English or German) will be presented during the conference in a reserved time slot. Additionally, the projects can be presented in the conference-blog on the conference-website after the conference (texts of about 5000-7500 characters).
