

## **1.1 What is argumentation?**

Argumentation is a method for problem solving in which a conflicting statement is disproved or affirmed through reasoning (Budke, 2012).

# **3 Results of the research**

There is 8.2% argumentation and reasoning task in the geography schoolbooks in Vietnam.

Argumentation and reasoning task in geographical context: The maximum is Human geography (48%), Human – Natural Interaction is 27 %, Physical geography is 18% and Topography is 7%.

Figure 1. Argument scheme (Toulmin, 2003 and Budke, 2011)


In the argument scheme (fig . 1), the conclusion is the statement being argued. A data is the facts or evidence used to prove the argument. A warrant is hypothetical logical statements that serve as bridges between the conclusion and data. The qualifier is statements that limit the strength of the statements. A rebuttal is a counter argument. A backing is statements that serve to the warrants.

### **1.3 Argumentation and reasoning**

An argumentation considers controversial conclusion and reason with data. A reasoning is a statement retreat with reasons in a causal relation.

Figure 4. Argumentation and reasoning in geography context into geography schoolbooks in Vietnam.






Figure 2. The relationship between argumentation and reasoning (Budke, 2012b)
