#### Role:

The applicant will support our work on an international, comparative research project. The project investigates digital public spheres on Twitter in the cities of Berlin and Jerusalem, especially regarding their geospatial characteristics. It is part of the SFB 1265 "Re-Figuration of Spaces". The applicant will help us with literature research and data collection, project administration, data analysis and publications.

### **Qualifications:**

We are looking for applicants who are enrolled as students in communication or related social sciences, Jewish or Arabic studies. Advanced Bachelor students or Master students preferred. Desired profile:

- Interest in empirical communication research and empirical research methods (particularly content and network analyses, analyses of geodata),
