

Spread of Giant Hogweed within a period of seven years

The panels show maps of Giant Hogweed (*Heracleum mantegazzianum* Somm. et Lev.) in 2002/03 and 2009/10. Older layers (grey) are laid over younger layers (blue), i.e. blue shows spread within seven years, while grey mostly represents persistent stands of Giant Hogweed. Dark grey and dark blue areas indicate dominant stands; dots indicate single plants (lighter colours) or groups of several plants (darker colours). Quadrats are 1 km².
