

Praktikum für Lehramtsstudierende in Irland

Galway Steiner National School (GSNS) in cooperation with the Centre for Teacher Education (Zentrum für Lehrerbildung) of University of Münster offers teacher students the possibility to do a school placement in Galway. Galway is located on the west coast of Ireland and is known for its festivals and music. It is a vibrant, fun-loving and historic city with an enjoyable social, musical and artistic life and will be the European Capital of Culture for 2020. GSNS was founded in September 2015 and is a growing school. It currently caters for children from 5 years old to 9 years old.

At GSNS education is based on Waldorf education and has an emphasis on movement, music, art, handwork, drama and outdoor learning. In a Steiner Kindergarten and Steiner school children learn through play and activities like gardening, house work, cooking and crafting rather than through instruction by the teachers and assistants. Therefore, all adults in the classrooms are expected to be active role models during the work and play activities. Volunteers at GSNS are going to be involved in a “hands on” education approach. In the lower classes, typical tasks as a volunteer include: Modelling of activities (art, cooking, crafting...) preparation and tidying up, assisting children when necessary, listening and talking to children. A lot of time is spent outdoors, including trips to the forest just a few minutes away. In the older classes, interns typically help with project work, reading groups, art, knitting etc.

GSNS will not offer accommodation but can help in finding accommodation, for example in a host family. Each intern at GSNS will have a mentor.
