DPSGF is located in the city of Faridabad and is spread over 17 acres of landscaped campus.

The internship period lasts at least **four weeks and up to six weeks (suitable as “Berufsfeldpraktikum”)**.

During the placement, interns will be assigned a timetable and will be able to interact with junior students (eight/nine-year-olds). Interns can get an insight into the subject areas English, maths, science, dance, music, art & craft and can even offer special classes on German culture.

While in school, lunch will be provided to the intern in the cafeteria. DPSGF will offer a transport facility via school bus/car for the travel between the school and place of stay. The pick up from the airport will also be taken care of. DPSGF will not offer accommodation or pay charges for the same. However, it will provide assistance in identifying a suitable accommodation in town.
