Data protection (by the data protection officer of the WWU) 2019:

The personal data you provide in course evaluations is anonymised before it is stored and processed, i.e. anonymisation makes it impossible to conclude your identity based on your responses. In addition to your opinion on the course in question, you are asked to provide additional data for statistical purposes, e.g. your major, semester, gender and age.

Under certain circumstances, however, this data could suffice to identify participants of the evaluation. If you are concerned your identity would be revealed on account of the limited size and/or the specific composition of the respective course, you may decide whether or not to answer certain questions.

If you are required to fill in blank fields in the questionnaire, please note that your handwriting or the content of your responses may allow conclusions to be drawn regarding your identity.
