

Important Information for ERASMUS Students at the Department of Psychology

How to choose your courses:

- First, get an impression of the course offer by reading the **course overview** (if not available, please ask the ERASMUS coordination of the department of psychology). There, you can also see if a course is available in the semester of your stay. Some courses are only available in either the winter or the summer semester.
- Second, specify your course choice by using the **online course catalogue**. It gives you concrete topics, teachers, times and credits points of the courses (as soon as it is available for your semester of stay). - Third, **contact the ERASMUS coordination** of the department of psychology for feedback. If you do so, please write down the course names, the course numbers and the given ECTS points. You find these information in the online course catalogue.
- You can also look for **courses of other faculties** (e.g. educational sciences) at the WWU, but any course outside the department of psychology requires that you contact the respective ERASMUS coordination (e.g. from the educational science) and ask for permission to participate.

Detailed information for your course choice:

- Bachelor students can only choose courses on bachelor level.
- Master and doctoral students can choose courses from both levels but it cannot be guaranteed that there are free courses on bachelor level.
- There are seminars (= about 25 students, no exam but a presentation or report, normally no grades) and lectures (= larger group, written exam at the end of the semester). If you want to have a grade in a seminar, you will have to inform the teacher at the beginning of the course.
- Our courses are structured in modules but you don't have to choose or complete whole modules during your stay.
- Everything will be in German, except for some seminars in English which you will find here: <https://www.uni-muenster.de/Psychologie/en/international/incoming/studium/index.html>
- To choose "Vertiefungen" (10 ECTS) you need to send a proof of basic knowledge (at least 8 ECTS) in the field (e.g. Clinical Psychology) to the ERASMUS coordination of the department of psychology. You can choose one "Vertiefung" each semester.
- The seminar "Gesprächsführung" requires very good language skills because the main part of the seminar consists of the training of conversational skills.
- Participation in the module "PSYo4 Experimental Research" is not possible.
- If necessary, you can change your course choice during the first weeks. But it cannot be guaranteed that there are still free places in the seminars.
- You are automatically enrolled for the exam of a chosen lecture but you can cancel the enrolment at any time by sending an email to the ERASMUS coordination of the department of psychology.
