

FAQ Student Research Projects

1) Who can apply?

Students of all faculties, who are enrolled at Münster University at the time of the application process and at the beginning of the project that shall be funded.

2) Which formats can be funded?

It is important that you present a project that has been initiated and will be conducted by you as a student. The project must have a sound scientific basis and be endorsed by a professor of Münster University. Depending on the subject culture, this could be a laboratory project, a visit to an archive or a conference, for example. Please find an overview on funded projects [here](#) [GER].

3) Do I receive a lump sum?

No, please submit a financing plan with your application, in which you list all costs of your planned project. These must be realistic and specific. If you cannot calculate the amount of costs yet, it might make sense to apply at a later point of time.

4) Which costs can I include in my financing plan?

Costs directly related to the implementation of research can be covered (e. g. consumables, laboratory expenses, travel costs). Personnel costs and infrastructure measures cannot be financed.

In principle, you can submit an application at any time. The Rectorate Committee for Research Affairs (RKF), which decides on your application, usually meets twice a semester.
