We expect the successful candidate to have teaching experience and to be willing to contribute to the planned Master's program on "Diversity and Social Inequality in Open Societies" as well as to the department of sociology's other B.A. and M.A. study programs.

We also expect the candidate to combine theory and empirical research, and to carry out research and teaching in the field of sociology of migration and diversity that covers at least two of the following topics:

- cultural hybridity
- social differentiation
- inequality and discrimination
- gender
- public spheres

We additionally value experience with third party funding, very good teaching evaluations, journal publications, the use of different methods of data collection and analysis, very good English skills and experience with international comparisons.

To be considered for this position, the candidate has to hold an above-average doctorate in sociology, and have obtained first additional academic achievements while working as an academic staff member at a university or non-university research institute, or working in a research position in business, industry, administration or other relevant social fields in Germany or abroad.
