ULB offers for doctoral candidates

> Literature research

Do you need specific titles or comprehensive literature for your specific topic? You will find suitable search tools on our research websites: local to international catalogues, specialist databases and search portals. Organise your research effectively – with the help of many research tips and information on specialist searches.

> Training and consulting

We offer differentiated training courses – from audio tours and literature research to literature management. You can register for these online. You will also find a wide range of learning videos in the ULB Tutor.

At the information desk, we can advise you on all aspects of literature research, how to obtain the desired titles and how to use the library. If you have any further questions, you can also get in touch with our specialist contacts.

> Literature management

With the help of pre-installed interfaces, you can transfer references from numerous catalogues and databases into a reference management programme. This allows you to automatically create a bibliography. Collaboration with word processing programmes is usually seamless.

The ULB offers a reference management programme for the University of Münster. The use of this software is free of charge for members of the university.

> Publish your dissertation

You can fulfil your publication obligation by submitting printed copies or by digital publication. The exact regulations and the various options can be found in the doctoral regulations of your faculty, or you can contact the Service Point for Publication – thesis office – at the ULB.

printed

You must submit a prescribed number of publisher's, copyshop or microfiche editions. Cumulative publications are also possible.

digital with miami

The ULB Münster publishes your dissertation on the university publication server miami and ensures permanent availability. Your rights as an author remain protected, the ULB only receives a simple right of use. In addition to the digital version, you must submit a few print copies to the ULB. The digital publication of a cumulative dissertation is also possible.

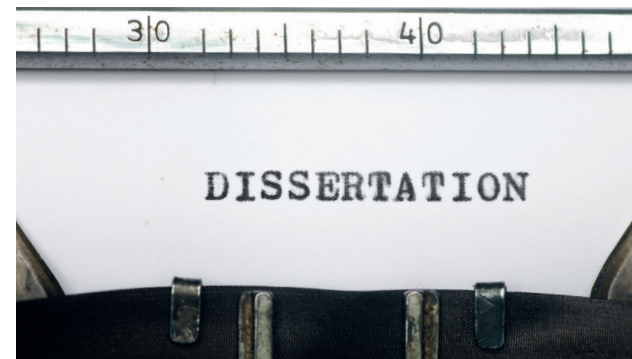
miami

miami, Münster's information and archive system for multimedia content, is the publication server for publishing and archiving digital documents and objects at the University of Münster.

miami enables free access to scientific information on the Internet and thus supports the goals of open access.

Publishing open access means:

- > publishing quickly
- > being easy to find
- > reach more readers
- > being cited more often
- > retain author's rights



digital & printed in the publication series of the University of Münster

If you have completed your doctorate with at least „magna cum laude“, you can publish in the series *University of Münster Academic Publications*. Your dissertation will be published as a gold open access publication and you also have to submit several copyshop copies to fulfil your publication obligation. The Staff at the Service Point for Publication will create the files for digital publication and for printing. Optionally, you can then publish your dissertation independently as a printed book with a publisher. This gives you all the advantages of both publication channels:

- > cost-effective and fast publication
- > long-term archiving of the online publication
- > citable via persistent identifiers
- > Notification to the 'Verzeichnis lieferbarer Bücher' (VLB)
- > optimal distribution and discoverability via search engines as well as book trade and library catalogues
- > reader-friendly print version thanks to the copyshop copies
- > optional bookstore edition at a favourable purchase price

You as the author finance the publication. We charge a service fee of 100 euros for our support and extra services. The printing costs vary depending on the service provider, the number of pages and the number of ordered copies.
