Supplementary Provisions on Data Protection

Regarding Applications for WiRe-Fellowships¹

In addition to the general Data Protection Policy of the University of Münster, the following provisions apply to applications for a WiRe-Fellowship.

Scope of data processing

When you apply via our online application process (application form to be submitted via email) for a WiRe-Fellowship, we gather and process the following personal data:

- (1) Your first and last name
- (2) Contact data (address, email address and phone number)
- (3) Information concerning your scientific education and career, your home university, your research project and dissemination strategy at the University of Münster
- (4) Your marital status / children, if applicable

Purpose of data processing

The personal information listed above is required in order to properly administer your application for a WiRe-Fellowship.

Legal basis for processing personal data

If we request your consent to process your personal data, Art. 6 (1 a) of the EU General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR) serves as the legal basis for processing this data.

If such processing is required to fulfil the terms of a contract of which you are a party, or to meet preliminary contractual obligations conducted on your behalf and at your request, Art. 6 (1 b) GDPR serves as the legal basis for processing this data.

If processing is necessary for the performance of a task carried out in the public interest or in the exercise of official authority vested in the University of Münster, Art. 6 (1 e) GDPR serves as the legal basis for processing this data.
