ESTIMATED COST FOR THE AU HEALTH INSURANCE PLAN

The rates below are for the 2017-18 academic year. Rates for Fall 2018 and Spring 2019 will be available in May 2018.

Health insurance is required for all students at AU. The waiver and the Enrollment Form will become available after the student receives the registration confirmation email. Students with private insurance may waive the AU health insurance to avoid charges; students should submit the waiver prior to the start of the semester to have the charge removed. Students who will not waive the health insurance should submit the Enrollment Form. Students who do not submit the waiver nor the Enrollment Form will be auto-enrolled in the plan, which will become active approximately four weeks after the start of the semester.
