

## Grant for a research stay of USP researchers at the University of Münster

In the frame of the DAAD supported Project **wwu.usp**, which aims at setting a strategic partnership with the University of São Paulo (USP) in Brazil, the Brazil Centre of the University of Münster (WWU) offers a financial grant for one USP-researcher (lecturer or post-doc) of any area who is interested in a research stay at the WWU for one month. An extension of the stay is possible at one's own account.

The grant serves the direct contact for discussion of bilateral cooperation projects with existing or future partners at the WWU. It covers costs for travel as well as residence in the form of an allowance for flight tickets (1250 Euros, economy class) and a monthly benefit of 2000 Euros, according to DAAD allowance rules.

- Start of activities: from July 1<sup>st</sup>, 2016

- Allowance money will be paid after arriving in Münster and on presentation of the corresponding bills.

- The call is valid for activities performed in 2016.
