

## Financial support for a short visit of WWU researchers to the University of São Paulo

In the frame of the DAAD supported Project **wwu.usp**, which aims at setting a strategic partnership with the University of São Paulo (USP) in Brazil, the Brazil Centre of the University of Münster (WWU) offers a financial grant for one researcher of any area who is interested in a short research stay at the USP for 18 days.

The grant serves the direct contact for the discussion of bilateral cooperation projects with existing or future partners at the USP. It covers costs for travel as well as residence, in the form of an allowance for flight tickets (economy class up to 1500 Euros) and a daily benefit (up to 164 Euros), according DAAD allowance rules and subjected to the LRKG.
